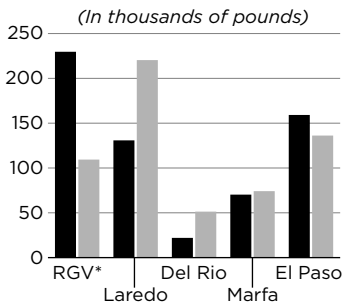


# BORDER PATROL DRUG SEIZURES

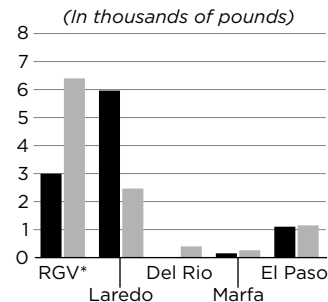
The Border Patrol statistics below include seizures made at checkpoints inland from the border.

■ Fiscal 2005 ■ Fiscal 2006 (through Sept. 13)

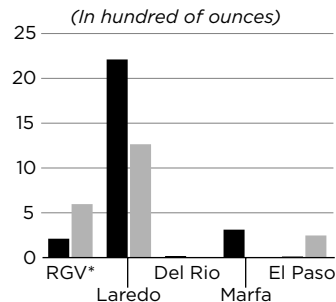

## Heroin



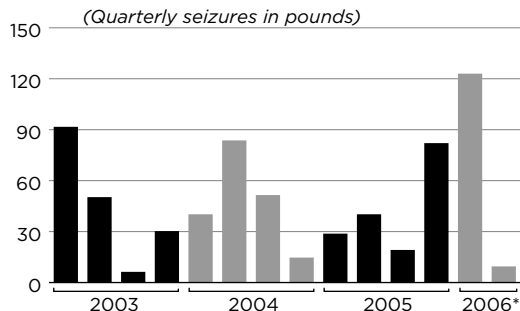

# CUSTOMS SEIZURES

U.S. Customs and Border Protection officers at eight South Texas ports of entry seized a significant amount of narcotics and currency during fiscal 2005 and 2006. Below are the totals:

Drug	Fiscal 2005	Fiscal 2006
Heroin	132 lbs.	101 lbs.**
Cocaine	10,588 lbs.	11,435 lbs.
Marijuana	79,640 lbs.	65,792 lbs.
Methamphetamine	627 lbs.	683 lbs.
Undeclared currency	\$5.7 million	\$9.8 million

# THE PRICE TO GET HIGH

Here's a look at the street price of various drugs in Texas cities.

Drug and quantity	Dallas	Houston	San Antonio
Powder cocaine, 1 ounce	\$600-\$900	\$400-\$650	\$500-\$700
Crack cocaine, 1 ounce	\$700-\$1,100	\$325-\$550	\$400-\$600
Heroin (Mexican black tar) 1 ounce	\$1,000-\$1,500	\$2,300-\$2,500	\$1,200-\$1,600
Mexican Meth (injectable) 1 ounce	\$400	\$500-\$850	\$700-\$1,000
Mexican Meth (ice) 1 ounce	\$1,400	\$700-\$1,200	\$1,000-\$1,500
Marijuana (commercial grade) 1 lb.	\$900-\$1,200	\$600	N/A
